GOLF TOURNAMENT 2025

Tournament Rules and Regulations

Day 1

Date: 3rd May 2025 (Saturday)

Golf course: Eighteen Golf Course (9H)

Maximum Participants: 50 Players

§1 General Rules

1. Eligibility

- The tournament is open to all players with a valid handicap. Players without a valid/active HCP will participate with a HCP of 0.
- The tournament is open to players aged 18 and over.
- **Maximum Handicap:**
 - Men: 18
 - Ladies: 36
- Players holding a handicap in a golf federation must submit an official certificate issued by the handicap-governing body via email to info@theclubateighteen.com at the time of registration. Otherwise, the player will compete with a HCP of 0.
- Each participant must register before the deadline.
- The tournament does not affect players' handicaps.

2. Registration

- Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The maximum number of participants is 50.
- Registration closes when the limit is reached or by the specified deadline (22nd April 2025).

3. Format

- The tournament will be played in stroke play format.
- The tournament will be played on 9 holes.
- Flight groups of 3-4 players will be determined by the organizers.

4. Starting Time

- All players must be at their designated starting holes 10 minutes before the start time.
- The official start time will be announced by the tournament committee. Starting times and group lists will be posted on the club's website www.theclubateighteen.com and emailed to players by 4:00 pm the day before the tournament.

5. Scoring

- Standard stroke play rules apply.
- The tournament follows the Maximum Score format:
 - Players must pick up the ball and record a score of Par +5 if they exceed the stroke limit for a hole.
- **Scoring under Maximum Score:**
 - If a player finishes the hole by holing out:
 - If the score is below the maximum, the actual number of strokes must be recorded.
 - If the score is equal to or above the maximum, the recorded score must be the maximum or higher.
 - If a player does not hole out:
 - No score needs to be recorded, or the maximum score should be entered.
- Players must exchange scorecards with their playing partners to ensure accurate scoring.

6. Tee Assignments

- Women: Red Tees
- Men: White Tees
- Senior (60 years or older): Yellow Tees

7. Prizes and Awards

- **Prizes will be awarded as follows:**
 - **Stroke Play Gross:** 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
 - **Stroke Play Net:** 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
 - **Best Lady:** Stroke Play Gross 1st place

- **On Course Competitions:**
 - **Longest Drive**
 - Designated hole for the competition will be announced before the start of the tournament.
 - The ball must come to rest within the fairway to qualify.
 - The longest drive will be measured and recorded by designated markers.
 - **Nearest to the Pin**
 - Designated hole for the competition will be announced before the start of the tournament.
 - The ball must come to rest on the green to qualify.
 - The nearest shot to the pin will be measured and recorded.
 - **Nearest to the Line**
 - Designated hole for the competition will be announced before the start of the tournament.
 - The ball must come to rest within the fairway to qualify.
 - The nearest to the line will be measured and recorded by designated markers.
 - **Hole in One**
 - Designated hole for the competition will be announced before the start of the tournament.
 - Only the first stroke of the hole counts for the Hole in One competition.
 - The first player to achieve a hole in one will be awarded a special prize.
- **Prize Eligibility:**
 - Prizes in the main Stroke Play Gross category (1st-3rd) are exclusive. A player winning a prize in the main category cannot win a prize in the Stroke Play Net categories. In such cases, the prize will be awarded to the next eligible player in the Net category.
- **Closing Ceremony:**
 - The awards presentation will take place on 4th May 2025 following the conclusion of the second day of the tournament. All participants are encouraged to attend the presentation ceremony. The registration fee includes lunch for players during the closing ceremony.

8. Ties

- In the event of a tie for 1st place in Strokeplay Gross, a playoff will determine the winner. The format and hole(s) for the playoff will be announced by the tournament committee.

- For all other ties, the winner will be determined by a count-back system, starting from the 9th hole and moving backwards.

§2 Course Rules

1. Etiquette

- Players must always adhere to standard golf etiquette.
- Respect other players, maintain a good pace of play, and take care of the course.

2. Local Rules

- Any local rules will be provided by the course and must be followed.
- Out-of-bounds and hazard areas will be marked clearly.

3. Equipment

- Only standard golf equipment is allowed.
- Players are responsible for their own equipment and its compliance with the rules.

4. Caddies and Carts

- Caddies are permitted.
- Golf carts are allowed, but their availability is limited. Members have priority for reservations, followed by guests.

5. Conduct and Disputes

- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.
- Any disputes or issues should be reported to the tournament committee immediately.
- The tournament committee's decisions are final.
- Any rule disputes will be resolved in accordance with the official rules of golf.

§3 Registration and Payment

1. Registration

- Registration must be completed through the online form at www.theclubateighteen.com.
- The registration fee includes participation in the tournament, a goodie bag, a lunch box, and lunch during the closing ceremony on the second day of the tournament, May 4th 2025.

2. Payment

- To secure participation, the entry fee must be paid within 3 days of registration. Participation is confirmed based on payment order.

#thegame

- Payments should be made to the organizer's account provided in the registration form.

§4 Withdrawal Policy

- Entry fees will be refunded only if withdrawal is communicated at least 14 days before the tournament date.
- Withdrawal requests must be submitted via email to info@theclubateighteen.com.
- Late withdrawal does not qualify for a refund.

§5 Regulation Amendments

- The tournament committee reserves the right to modify these rules if necessary.

By participating in the tournament, players agree to abide by these rules and regulations.
