



Diplomatic Golf Tournament

Rules and Regulations

Date: 4th October 2025 - Saturday

Golf course: Eighteen Golf Course (18 H)

Maximum number of Players: 40

§1 General Rules

1. Eligibility

- The tournament is open to players aged 18 and over.
- Players holding a handicap in a golf federation must submit an official certificate issued by the handicap-governing body via email to info@theclubateighteen.com at the time of registration. Otherwise, the player will compete with a HCP of 0.
- **Maximum Handicap:**
 - Men: 18
 - Ladies: 36

2. Registration

- Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis with priority to The Club Eighteen Members
- Registration closes when the limit is reached or by the deadline – 30th September 2025
- Registration must be completed through the online form at www.theclubateighteen.com

3. Format

- The tournament will be played in an individual stroke play format.
- The tournament will be played on 18 holes.

4. Starting Time Shotgun 8:00

- All players must be at their designated starting holes 10 minutes before the start time.
- Group lists will be posted on the club's website www.theclubateighteen.com and emailed to players by 5:00 pm the day before the tournament.

5. Scoring

- The tournament follows the Maximum Score format:
- Players don't have to hole out, they may pick up the ball and record a score of Par +5 if they exceed the stroke limit for a hole.
- Players must exchange scorecards with their playing partners to ensure accurate scoring.

6. Tee Assignments

- Women: Red
- Men: White
- Senior, Veteran (55 years or older): Yellow

7. Prizes and Awards

- Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - **Stroke Play Gross:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd place
 - **Best Lady:** Stroke Play Gross 1st place
 - **Best Senior/Veteran:** Stroke Play Gross 1st place
 - **Stroke Play Net:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd place
- On Course Competitions:
 - **Hole in One – Hole 6**
 - The ball must go into the hole with a single shot.
 - **Longest Drive - Hole 5**
 - The ball must come to rest within the fairway to qualify.
 - **Nearest to the Pin – Hole 3**
 - The ball must come to rest on the green to qualify.
- **Prize Eligibility:**
 - Prizes in the main Stroke Play Gross category are exclusive. A player winning a prize in the main category cannot win a prize in the Stroke Play Net category. In such cases, the prize will be awarded to the next eligible player in the Net category.
- **Prizegiving Ceremony:**
 - The Ceremony will take place in the Academy following the conclusion of the tournament.

8. Ties

- In the event of a tie for 1st place in Strokeplay Gross, a playoff will determine the winner. The format and hole(s) for the playoff will be announced by the tournament committee.
- For all other ties, the winner will be determined by a count-back system, starting from the 9th hole and moving backwards.

§2 Course Rules

1. Etiquette

- Players must follow standard golf etiquette.
- Respect other players, maintain a good pace of play, and take care of the course.

2. Local Rules

- Any local rules will be provided by the course and must be followed.

3. Caddies and Carts

- Caddies are permitted. The organizer may provide caddie at price of 5000 PKR
- Golf carts are allowed, but their availability is limited. Members and seniors have priority for reservations.

4. Conduct and Disputes

- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.
- Any disputes or issues should be reported to the tournament committee immediately.
- The tournament committee's decisions are final.
- Any rule disputes will be resolved in accordance with the R&A and USGA rules of golf.

§3 Payment

- The Entry is free for all the Diplomats and Club Members.
- The Entry fee for non-diplomats is 15,000 PKR.
- The Entry fee includes breakfast & lunch, participation in the tournament, prize giving ceremony and the lottery
- To secure participation, the entry fee must be paid within 24 hours of registration. Participation is confirmed based on payment order.
- Payments should be made to the organizer's account provided in the registration form.

§4 Withdrawal Policy

- Entry fees will be refunded only if withdrawal is communicated at least 14 days before the tournament date.
- Withdrawal requests must be submitted via email to info@theclubateighteen.com.
- Late withdrawal does not qualify for a refund.

§5 Regulation Amendments

- The tournament committee reserves the right to modify these rules if necessary.

By participating in the tournament, players agree to abide by these rules and regulations.
